

The Brenton Jacob Memorial Fund (BJMF) was founded in 2013 to honor Brenton, a 2004 ERHS graduate, who passed away at the age of 26.

Brenton was a devoted baseball fan and talented player throughout his life. His passion for the sport was ignited during his first experience on the field through the East Rochester Little League program. The rules of the game symbolized life lessons for Brenton, which helped shape the respectful, dedicated and caring young man we will always remember.

Our organization honors his memory and creates opportunities for children to discover their *own* passion and talent.

Thanks to your continued generosity since 2013, the BJMF has:

- **Paid 107 youth sports registrations**
- **Sent 12 kids to the Williamsport Little League Camp**
